A covenant is a promise or agreement. The Covenant of Faithfulness includes the promises we as a church and you as the parent and student make in preparing students for confirmation.

The journey to confirmation began at the time of baptism and continues with a personal commitment of lifelong faithfulness as a disciple of Jesus Christ.

### As a church, we promise to:

- provide instruction in the Christian faith
- provide opportunities for worship
- provide Midweek School instruction
- provide Sunday School instruction

### As parents or guardians, we promise to:

- make our relationship with God a priority in our family
- work together with St. Mark's in training our child as a disciple of Jesus Christ
- participate in daily personal devotions with our child
- bring our child to Midweek and Sunday School classes

### As students, we promise to:

- make our relationship with God a priority
- attend worship services at least two times a month
- attend all Midweek sessions
- complete assignments and memory work
- attend Sunday School when attending worship
- prepare to confirm the faith confessed at our baptism
